Changes Coming to Brumby Way in Downtown Tifton

During October 2015 bidding will begin on the Brumby Way Project in Downtown Tifton. The project will consist of roadway, sidewalk, lighting, and landscaping improvements. The project is being funded by Federal Highway and City of Tifton. The project area will not only bring beautification to downtown, but when the project is finished the one way traffic pattern will change. Currently vehicles enter Brumby Way on Main Street and travel east toward Tift Avenue. Once the project is completed the direction of the one way traffic will change. Vehicles will then enter Brumby Way on Tift Avenue and end at Main Street.


Qualifying Period Set For City Council Candidates
