



This Holiday Season

The Tifton-Tift County Utilities Department wants residents to “Cease Fats, Oils & Grease” in the kitchen this holiday season. Improperly disposed of Fats, Oil & Grease (FOG) can harm the environment by creating overflows/blockages in the city sanitary sewer lines and homeowner pipes that may cause property damage, foul odors and road closures due to pipe repairs.

Following these easy steps in FOG Disposal will save you money \$\$ this holiday season:

Do’s Scrape and wipe excess FOG using paper towels from kitchenware and cooking surfaces prior to washing . Place FOG saturated paper towels in the trash.

Allow FOG from baking, frying and deep fryers to cool. Pour FOG into a sealed container. Place container in trash.

Don’t: Pour FOG into the toilet, storm drain or sink. Hot water and dish detergent do not breakdown or destroy Fats, Oils, & Grease.
