

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR PROPOSALS**  
**TRAVELING BRIDGE FILTER REHABILITATION**  
**CITY OF TIFTON, GA**

The City of Tifton, GA is inviting all interested parties to submit a Proposal for **Traveling Bridge Filter Rehabilitation** at the Tifton Regional Wastewater Treatment Complex (TRWTC) located at 80 Old Brookfield Road, Tifton, GA 31794.

Sealed Proposals for the **Traveling Bridge Filter Rehabilitation** will be received by Becky Moore, at the City's office, 120 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Tifton, Georgia 31794, until 3:00 PM local time on Thursday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016. Proposals may be mailed or hand delivered. The owner will evaluate all proposals received based on the technology proposed, experience of the manufacturer and installer, references contacted, and proposed pricing for the complete system. The company submitting the winning proposal shall be notified in writing by the owner at which time contract negotiations will commence.

The work to be done generally consists of demolition of the existing traveling bridge filter equipment and installation of a new low head, automatic backwash filter system capable of treating municipal wastewater secondary effluent. The proposal price shall provide for a complete package including all tools, labor, equipment, expertise, overhead, and profit required to provide a complete and in-place, working system.

A non-mandatory pre-proposal meeting/site visit will be held on Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM EST at the Wastewater Treatment Complex. The purpose of the meeting will be to allow interested parties to view the existing filter basin and to address any questions or concerns.
