**1. BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS AND REPRESENTATIONS**

1.01 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents, to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

1.02 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

1.03 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:

A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:

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B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local laws and regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- E. Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, with the Bidding Documents.
- F. Bidder has given Owner or Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Owner or Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- G. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.
- H. Bidder will submit written evidence of its authority to do business in the State of Georgia not later than the date of execution of the Agreement.

1.04 Bidder further represents that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over Owner.

2. BASIS OF BID

2.01 Bidder will complete the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the unit prices listed on the Bid Schedule (pages 00410-6 through 00410-9), attached hereto and made a part of this Bid Form). Bidder acknowledges that quantities are not guaranteed and final payment will be based on actual quantities determined in accordance with the provisions of Section 109 of the GDOT Standard Specifications. 2.02 In the event that the envisioned Scope of Work changes and modifications are required, as determined by the Owner and Engineer, the Contract price will be adjusted in accordance with the indicated prices for Unit Price Items identified on the Bid Schedule. Final payment for Unit Price Items will be based on the actual quantities approved by the Owner and Engineer, multiplied by the indicated unit prices.

3. TIME OF COMPLETION

3.01 For this project an overall completion date has been established for December 31, 2017. However to minimize pedestrian impacts a separate contract time has been established. The contractor may begin work after the Notice to Proceed with Construction has been issued by the City of Tifton; however the contractor shall be substantially complete within **120** days of starting work. Failure to meet the required completion date of December 31, 2017 will result in liquidated damages per GDOT specification 108.08. Work must be substantially complete by December 31, 2017 after the date when the Contract Time commences to run, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the Contract Documents within **30** calendar days after the date of issuance of the Certificate of Substantial Completion.

3.02 Bidder accepts the provisions of Section 108.08 of the GDOT Standard Specifications as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the Contract Times.

**SPECIAL PROVISION**

**Section 150—TRAFFIC CONTROL PROJECT:  
PI No. 0010674**

Add the following Sub-Section to Section 150:

**150.11 SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

- A. The Contractor shall not perform work, close lanes, or move equipment or materials on the portions of the roadways between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Failure to remove lane closures or remove materials and equipment from traveled way accordingly will result in the assessment of Liquidated Damages at the rate of \$300 per hour. Equipment or materials moved on or across the travel way at other times shall be done in a manner as not to unduly interfere with traffic.
- B. The City of Tifton shall be notified in writing a minimum of one week prior to any proposed weekend closures, detours, or traffic pacing. No lane closures, detours, or pacing of traffic, will be allowed from the day preceding any National Holiday through the first workday after the Holiday, inclusive.
- C. The Contractor shall submit a written notice to the Engineer for approval (14) fourteen days prior to the closure. After receiving approval from the engineer for the closure, the Contractor shall install signs in accordance with the MUTCD, to inform the traveling public of the proposed closure, including the date of the closure. The sign shall be placed (5) five days prior to the closure.
- D. No construction activity will be allowed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
