**Ordinance Amending the Distance Requirements of the City's Alcohol Beverage Ordinance**


City Attorney Rob Wilmot reviewed the discussion of the proposed changes and mentioned the state law allows for local governments to reduce the distance requirements provided by state law for school grounds. He reviewed the proposed amendments reducing the distance requirements for package stores from a college campus to 100 yards. Council reviewed and briefly discussed. Vice Mayor Folk commented that the distance is measured to the property line and not to the actual campus buildings. Mayor Smith called for the vote. Council Member Cromer made the first motion for approval of the ordinance, motion seconded by Reynolds, and unanimously approved. Ordinance adopted.

**Ordinance Extending the 90 Day Moratorium on Planned Development Overlays (PDO)**


